Martha Lindenberg Vaught was President/artist in 431 in 1992-3, and was interviewed for the preparations for exhibition and had art included in this museum exhibition. In 1984, Massachusetts Avenue began its transformation from a spot few people wanted to go to the place where everyone wanted to be. That year, 17 artists formed a collective and opened 431 Gallery in a storefront at 431 Massachusetts Avenue. Alongside other ground-breaking galleries, 431 allowed its artists to show their sculptures, paintings and photographs — cutting-edge art that was different than anything else happening in Indianapolis at the time - in a setting that was both unique and poised for revitalization. 431 Gallery: Art and Impact is a glimpse back in time to the beginning of a new art scene in Indianapolis, and the influence it had on the community that supported it.
